Portico provides comprehensive ELCA-Primary health benefits through partnerships with BlueLink (medical and mental health benefits) and Express Scripts (prescription drug benefits). **In addition, Portico offers resources to help ELCA Health Plan members enrolled in ELCA-Primary health benefits address health needs and support long-term well-being — most at no additional cost.** Members can sign in to *myPortico.PorticoBenefits.org* to learn more about these and other resources.

Need Medical Care?**Medical Benefit**

Helps you pay for medically necessary, eligible medical care expenses. Eligible medical services for treatment or diagnosis of an illness, injury, or physical condition must be provided by state-licensed professionals and facilities — whether it's in a clinic, a hospital, an emergency room, etc.

Before a first visit or if your care requires pre-certification (see list on back of your Portico Health ID card), call a Quantum Health Care Coordinator at Quantum Health (877.851.5656) to confirm that the provider is in-network (costs you less) or to pre-certify your care.

First Step:

- Visit provider, show your Portico Health ID card.

**Text-Based Care**

Text-based visits with a care team that includes board-certified physicians and other providers are available 24/7 to treat the full spectrum of non-urgent concerns virtually — no appointment necessary — \$8 copay if you have Silver+ or Bronze+ and \$0 copay for all other benefit options. The care provider can diagnose and treat illnesses and order necessary prescriptions and laboratory tests (out-of-pocket costs for prescriptions and tests depend on which ELCA-Primary health option you have).

First Step:

- Download the 98point6 app, sign in with your mobile phone number, create a profile, and verify your identity so you're ready for a first visit.

Time for a Checkup, Screening, or Vaccination?

Medical Benefit

Pays 100% of the cost for eligible preventive services delivered by an in-network provider, including vision examination, screenings, checkups, and immunizations.

First Step:

- Call a Quantum Health Care Coordinator (877.851.5656) to find an in-network provider.
- Then, visit provider and show your Portico Health ID card.



Need Mental Health Care?

Mental Health Benefit

Helps you pay for medically necessary, eligible mental health care expenses. Eligible mental health services, including assessment, counseling, medication management, detoxification, and addiction treatment must be provided by state-licensed professionals and facilities.

Before a first visit or if your care requires pre-certification (see list on back of your Portico Health ID card), call a Quantum Health Care Coordinator (877.851.5656) to confirm that the provider is in-network (costs you less) or to pre-certify your care.

First Step:

- Visit provider, show your Portico Health ID card.



Online Mental Health Programs

Coach-supported, self-paced, interactive programs help those age 13+ change behavior patterns based on proven principles of Cognitive Behavioral Therapy. Confidential and available 24/7 at no additional cost to you, programs address anxiety, stress, social anxiety, depression, insomnia, panic, substance use, and resilience.

First Step:

Employee Assistance Program (EAP)

Struggling with problems related to grief, marriage, parenting, work-related challenges, finances, or substance use? EAP is a great first step. It can connect you with a master's-level professional counselor who can provide up to six covered sessions per issue at no added cost to you. EAP benefits also include Talkspace, which allows you to engage with a licensed counselor 24/7 either on your phone or laptop, via voice, text, or video. Talkspace counselors set their own hours and help with issues such as anxiety, depression, trauma, grief, substance use, stress, and more. One week of unlimited text messages counts as one session.

Want to Fill a Prescription?

Prescription Drug Benefit

Helps you pay for eligible prescription drugs. Your out-of-pocket cost will depend on which ELCA-Primary health benefit option you have.

- If taking a drug for 31 days or less, fill at a local in-network pharmacy using your Portico Health ID card.
- Members can fill a 90-day supply medication at their "Personalized Retail Pharmacy" — either CVS or Walgreens (but not both).
- If taking a drug on an ongoing basis, you may be able to save money by ordering online or by phone through Express Scripts' home delivery service. 800.575.8090 24/7; TTY/TDD 800.305.5376; express-scripts.com.
- If taking a specialty drug (very costly oral and injectable drugs with specific storage requirements, complex instructions, for serious/complex illnesses), you must order through Express Scripts subsidiary, Accredo Specialty Drug Pharmacy. 800.803.2523, Mon. – Fri. 7 a.m. – 8 p.m., Sat. 8 a.m. – noon (Central).

First Step:

- Ask your provider to prescribe lower-cost generic or preferred brand-name option.
- Tip: Share *Drug Formulary List* with provider (found on myPortico).



Want Help with Diabetes or Heart Disease?

Chronic Condition Prevention Program

This Omada program is designed to help members who qualify create modest changes that promote weight loss and help reduce the risk of Type 2 diabetes and heart disease. With no additional out-of-pocket cost, participants receive access to the following features:

- Professional coach for one-on-one guidance
- Wireless smart scale to monitor progress
- Weekly online lessons to educate and inspire
- Small online peer group for real-time support

Diabetes Management Program

Those with Type 1 or Type 2 diabetes who use the ELCA prescription drug benefit for diabetes supplies and medications are eligible for this Omada program. At no additional cost, participants receive access to:

- A continuous glucose monitor and a blood glucose meter that provides personalized tips and enables sharing readings with others, replacing the need for logbooks
- A scale
- Unlimited test strips and lancets, shipped directly whenever needed
- Coaching from Certified Diabetes Educators, available 24/7/365

Hypertension Management Program

The Omada program helps those with high blood pressure:

- Lose weight
- Manage their blood pressure with diet and medication
- Measure their blood pressure with a provided blood pressure cuff and connected scale if needed
- Get coaching and support by a trained hypertension provider

The goal of these programs is to keep members who have chronic health issues such as hypertension or diabetes-related hypertension stay on track and stay motivated. There is no additional cost for these benefits.

Offering something for everyone, Burnalong's virtual health and fitness platform provides thousands of on-demand and live classes with social motivation and no additional cost.

Burnalong+ gives you access to the gyms and fitness centers in the Burnalong+ network. You can use all the amenities available with a standard membership: equipment, group classes, pools, sauna, or childcare. You can opt in and join Burnalong+ for \$29 per month when you enter your credit card information on the Burnalong site. There are no activation or cancellation fees — join or cancel any time.

The ELCA Medical and Dental Benefits Plan is administered by Portico for use by the ELCA and church-affiliated organizations. While every effort is made to ensure the information contained herein is correct, the applicable legal plan document(s), policy(ies), or program(s) will control in the event of any omission or misstatement. Benefit plans are governed and administered individually through separate plan documents. Portico (and its designee, insurer, or claims administrator, as applicable) will have the power, including, without limitation, discretionary power, to make all determinations that the plan(s) require for its administration, and to construe and interpret the plan(s) for purposes of determining eligibility and benefits. The health and disability benefit plans are self-insured and are not provided through an insurance company, with the exception of the Medicare Advantage benefit and ELCA Part D drug benefit under the health plan and the insurance benefit under the disability benefits plan. Each plan's assets are held in separate trusts; accordingly, one plan cannot fund another's shortfall. Portico's ability to pay claims is dependent upon continued contributions, claims experience, and market performance. Portico has contracted with an insurance company to administer the Medicare Advantage benefit and the ELCA Part D drug benefit. Portico reserves the right to change any plan terms at any time through the amendment or termination process described in each plan document. Plan documents are available by contacting Portico.

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
